

Report on Faculty FDP conducted from 10.10.2023 to 16.10.2023

The Faculty Development Program was organized under the aegis of the Ministry of Education's Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNTT) Scheme, which aims to empower teachers and enhance the quality of teaching and learning in higher education.
