Outcome:



The speakers were Ms. Ujwala and Ms. Darshana, who explained the topic very well through several interactive exercises, day-to-day examples, videos, etc.


About 100 students from the Senior and Junior College, as also a few teachers attended the workshop, which received rave reviews.




