Dr. Anil Chougule from the Department of Economics provided guidance and insights during the session, enriching the discussion with his expertise in economic perspectives on AI adoption in education.

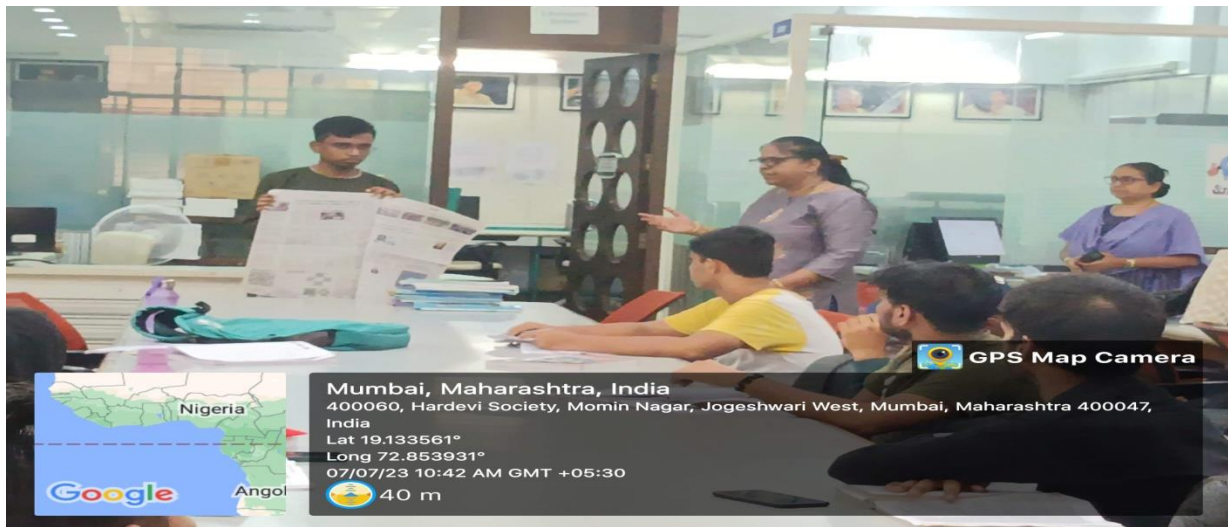




7th July, 2023:

She elaborated on the scientific objectives of Chandrayaan-3, including its aims to study the Moon's surface composition, geological features, and the presence of water molecules.





4th August, 2023:

This session was conducted in the main reading room by Ms. Riddi Dubey FYBA. The session focused on India's initiative to conserve 11 species of endangered wild cats, as reported in the magazine 'Pratiyogita Darpan' (Jan 2023, Vol.17 issue.196, pg.52) under the News Chapter 'Divya Darpan.' She elaborated on India's collaboration with the Global Environment Facility (GEF), a US-based establishment, in this conservation effort. She discussed the importance of preserving these species, highlighting their ecological significance and the threats they face in their natural habitats.

The session was graced by the presence of Prof. Dr. Smt. Bhavita Chavan, the respected Principal of our College. Dr. Chavan shared insights on the importance of wildlife conservation and encouraged students to actively participate in initiatives such as "The animal rescue club" in the zoology department. She emphasized the role of youth in promoting environmental awareness and taking concrete steps towards protecting endangered species.

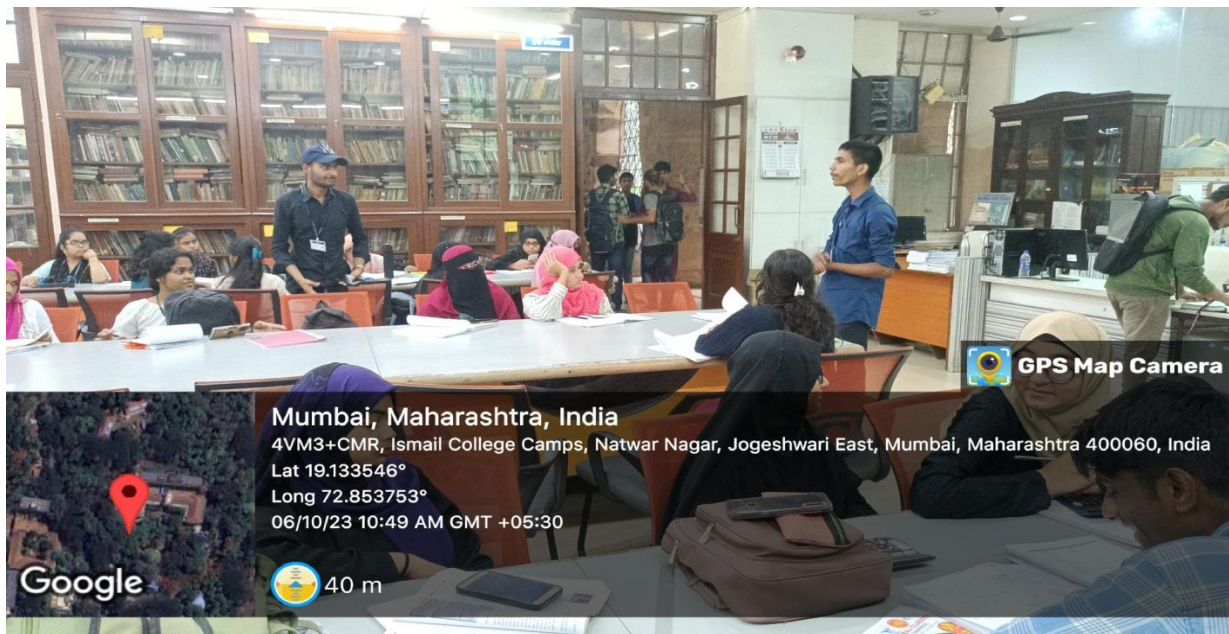
8th Sep, 2023:

6th Oct, 2023:

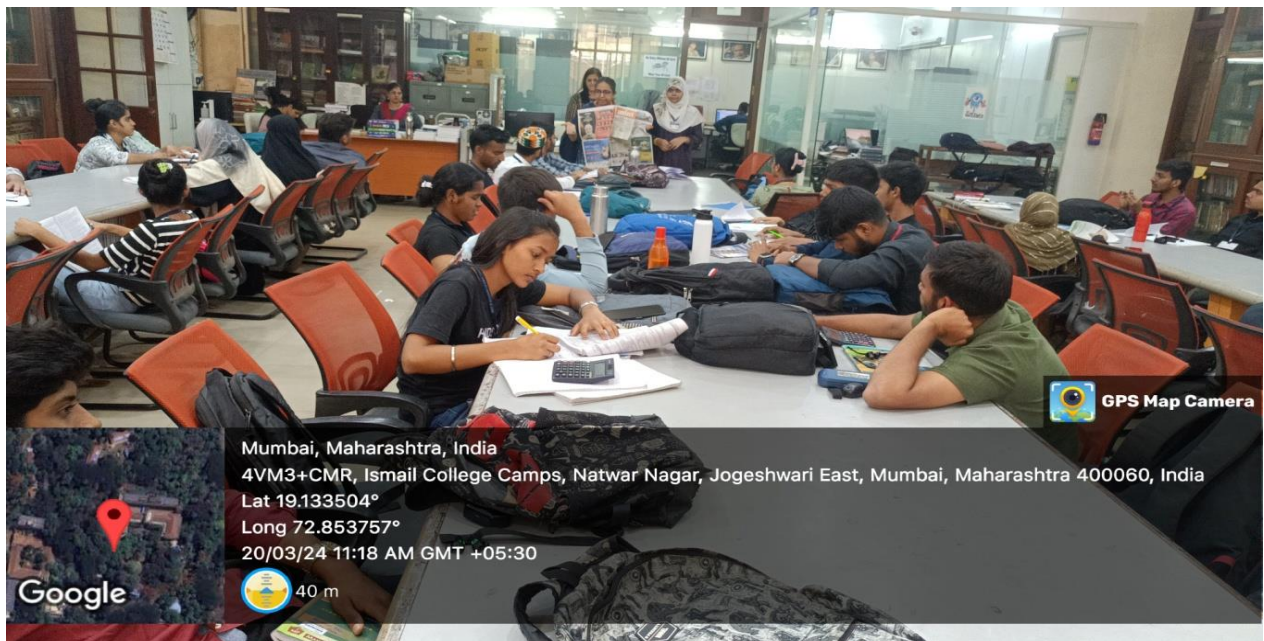
