1. Introduction of Tamper-proof Marksheets with High Security Features

Discussion:

The committee discussed the need for tamper-proof marksheets to ensure authenticity and prevent fraudulent activities.

Proposed security features include tear free paper, holograms, QR codes, and encrypted digital signatures to be printed on security press.

A demonstration of the proposed security features was presented.

Decisions:

The proposal was approved unanimously.

Result Committee was instructed to oversee the implementation process.

The timeline for the rollout is set for the next Academic Year.

Action taken:

Marksheet with 15 high security features along with a mobile verification application was approved for the implementation from next Academic Year. Security Software & Solutions LLP Mumbai was selected for providing the marksheets along with Next Generation Document Security Solution SeQR Doc Software.

2. Health and Well-being Initiatives

Discussion:

The importance of physical and mental health for students and staff was emphasized. Proposed initiatives included regular health check-ups, mental health workshops, and fitness programs.

Collaboration with local health professionals and wellness centers was suggested.

Decisions:

1. Online Sports & Cultural Events
