- 5. Event Duration: MEC sets start and end dates for the event, allowing up to 60 months in the past. Start and end times are optional, offering flexibility.
- Specialization Keywords: MEC selects specialization keywords during event creation. Activities of collaborators and participants matching these keywords are highlighted and published on the ME Page.
- 7. Medium: MEC chooses the mode of the ME, such as Volunteer Events Creation, shaping the overall experience and focus of the event.
- Activity Type: MEC selects activity types, like Volunteer Opportunity or Experiential Learning Opportunity. Selected activities, aligned with specialization, continue to be featured post-ME duration.
- The Event Participant section provides insights into active and past participants. Participants can
 accept or decline invites. Accepted participants contribute to activities matching the ME
 specialization, published during and after the event.

The Collaborator section displays active and past collaborators. Collaborators have the additional privilege to invite other participants. Information is visible if there are more than three collaborators.


- Experiential Learning: By navigating to experiential learning you can find and apply for Experiential Learning Opportunities around your vicinity.
