Exploring Maharashtra's Contribution in Nation Building since Independence

18th January 2023

The Conference Report

The Introductory speech – Dr. Swati Wavhal, Principal, Ismail Yusuf College

The conference had explored, at length, Maharashtra's contribution to national development since independence. It emphasised State's contribution to Industrial, financial, political and social development. The conference refreshed State's preponderance in nation's progress. The conference was a part of celebrations on the occasion of 75th years of independence. The college had brought together a diverse group of resource persons, including Dr. Sadanand More, former Head of the Department of Philosophy, University of Pune so as to enlighten young generation on States' contribution to national development.

The key note address – Dr. Sadanand More, former Head of the Department of Philosophy, University of Pune.

Dr. More's key note speech laid out an overarching context of State's formation in the context of freedom movement. He explained Maharashtra's pre-eminence with regard to freedom movement. Also, he illuminated the role Maharashtra played in formation of national consciousness and its subsequent growth. He effectively analysed Maharashtra's unique contribution to nation building, pre-independence as well as after independence. He specifically spotlighted contribution of Smt. Saviti Bai Pule, Shi. Shahu Maharaj, and Dr. B.R. Ambedkar.

The Chief Guest - Dr. Asmita Vaidhya, Principal, Government Law College, Mumbai.

The Chief Guest, Dr. Vaidhya provided a review of laws for women's rights, empowerment and their participation in national development from 1950s to 1990 and thereafter. She also characterised Maharashtra contribution as an embodiment of "state of ethics" for others to follow. She also enumerated challenges before women - dowry, domestic violence and harassment at work place - and the legal remedies available.

With Chief Guests' address the inauguration session of the conference got concluded.

The first guest speaker - Dr. Jaswandi Wamburkar, Head of the Department of History, SNDT University, Mumbai.

Dr. Jaswandi narrated at length, Maharashtra Women's contribution to nation-building. She elucidated Smt. Iravati Karve's anthropological, pedagogical and Indic studies and Smt. Durgatai Bhagvat's role in literary studies. She, furthermore, stipulated Maharashtra women's contribution to Classical Music, cinema and theatre and highlighted the role of numerous periodicals in women's empowerment.

The second guest speaker - CA Avinash Ghare

CA, Avinash Ghare, explained growing financialization of economy and Maharashtra's contribution to it. He predicted that Maharashtra is likely to be a five trillion economy by 2035. He said the State is on the verge of becoming an important part of global value chain and a leading industrial, commercial and entertainment hub. Mumbai, Mr. Ghare believed, will retain its eminence not just in the country but in the region, given Mumbai's sustained growth - vertical as well as horizontal.

The third guest speaker - Dr. Sajaudeen Chapparband, Assistant Professor, Centre for Diaspora Studies, Central University of Gujarat

Dr. Sajaudeen's talk on 'the Global Marathi: An Overview of Marathi Community in Israel and their contribution to India' explored human migration besides defining meaning of diaspora. He elucidated contribution of Marathi people abroad. He illustrated economic remittances of Marathi people by showcasing it through developments in cultural landmarks. His presentation was based on extensive and meticulous use of statistical data, maps and graphs.

The fourth guest speaker - Mr. Mahendra Inge, Head HR, Serum Institute of India Ltd. Pune.

Mr. Inge explained contribution of Serum Institute in manufacturing and distribution of various vaccines for containing outbreaks of viruses than endanger human lives like, cholera, malaria, Ebola, tuberculosis and Covid – 19. He showed a video of Serum Institute and its manufacturing processes. His presentation was an outline of vaccine development and Maharashtra's contribution to it. Also, it was one of the succinct but powerful presentations.

The fifth guest speaker - Mr. Sandeep Jogdand, Assistant Professor of Public Administration, Govt. College, Aurangabad

Mr. Jogdand elaborated, at length, contribution of social, literary and renaissance movements from Maharashtra to the formation and rise of national consciousness. He analysed the process of political awareness, its spread and consolidation among subalterns and subsequent demand for equal rights, equal opportunity and social justice. He illuminated the rise and role of Dalit movement in raising awareness on socioeconomic and political conditions of Bahujans and reiterated importance of struggle for their emancipation. Mr. Jogdand also analysed ideas of Shri. Shahu Maharaj and Dr. B. R. Ambedkar.

With this presentation, the second session was concluded.

The Valedictory Session - Dr. Nandu Mulmule, M. D. (Psychiatric), Author, Presenter and Stress Management Expert

Dr. Mulmule explained, in effective fashion, how to organise our priorities in life and how to get maximum happiness from them. He insisted on significance of simple life as against the life full of inconsequential activities. He illustrated these and other simple facts of real happiness and their profound impact on our lives by citing example of Saint Dnyaneshwar, Saint Tukaram and others.

Simultaneous with second session, we had presentations from other invited researchers who also highlighted Maharashtra's contribution to nation-building. In total, fourteen (14) research papers were presented during the session.

We are going to publish, very soon, all the papers presented in a referred journal '**Research Journey**'. Our faculty members, research scholars, and students had hugely benefited the knowledge engendered during the conference. The conference had reiterated, reinforced ascendancy of the State of Maharashtra in India and beyond.
